# Geisenheimer ROTHENBERG



The world's oldest site classification map, created in 1867, was rediscovered in 2011. Even then the Rothenberg was assigned the highest possible classification. Today we produce 1,200 bottles annually from the site's 46-year-old vines, to be aged for at least 40 months on the lees.

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VARIETY: Riesling

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SEKT IDEA: Terroir-typical, full of grand finesse and enduring tension. For this single site sekt, a well-balanced acidity vies step-for-step with refreshing minerality.

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NICE TO KNOW: The landmark vineyard for our Geisenheim estate was first mentioned in official documents in the 12th century.
